# **PROSPECTUS**

#### A CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE IN HIGHER EDUCATION

Swamy Saswathikananda College was established in the year 2002, as a Self Financing Arts and Science College affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. The college is managed by the Branch 1103 of S.N.D.P. Yogam. Over the past years, the college has developed into one of the best self financing colleges under Mahatma Gandhi University and has won many laurels at the academic level. The infrastructure and the highly qualified faculty of the college provide an ambience suited for higher education. The college is situated on a peaceful campus close to the Ernakulam-Kottayam road at Poothotta, housing several educational institutions, all managed by the S.N.D.P. Branch 1103, Poothotta.



#### Bachelor of Computer Applications (B.C.A.) 60 seats

Eligibility: Bachelor of Computer Applications (Honours): Candidates shall be required to have passed the Plus Two/equivalent examination with ComputerScience/Mathematics/Statistics/Accountancy/Informatics Practices as one of the optional subjects

#### **Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) (Honours)**

Candidate shall be required to have passed Plus Two or equivalent examination or an examination recognized as equivalent there to by this University.

#### B.Sc., Computer Science (Honours) 60 seat

Candidates shall be required to have passed the Plus Two/equivalent examination in science stream with Mathematics/Computer Science as compulsory subjects.

### B.Com. (Honours) 160 seats 1. Finance & Taxation 2. Logistics Management,

#### 3. Co-Operation 4. Accounting

Eligibility: Plus Two or equivalent examination with Book-Keeping and Accountancy and any two of the following subjects as optional under part III: 1. Commerce; 2. Commercial Correspondence and Commercial Geography; 3. Economics; 4. Life Insurance and Salesmanship; 5. Banking with Secretarial Practice; 6. Business Studies; 7. Mathematics; 8. Computer Science / Computer Application; 9. Informatics Practices and Management; 10. Informatics Practices; 11. Management; 12. Accountancy

OR

Plus Two or equivalent examination with at least 45% of the aggregate marks.

#### B.A. English (Honours)

Eligibility: Plus Two or equivalent examination

#### B. Sc. Cyber Forensics (Honours) 24 seats

Candidates shall be required to have passed the Plus Two/equivalent examination with aggregate of 55% for any of the three of the subjects viz. Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology and Computer Science and 50% marks for Mathematics alone.

#### **RELAXATION**

For SC/ST applicants and ST applicants of Lakshadweep, only a pass minimum is required and for SEBC and OEC applicants 3% and 5% relaxation marks respectively are allowed.

#### M.Com. Finance & Taxation 30 seats

Eligibility: B.Com. / BBA / BBM with not less than CGPA of 1.80 out of 4 in the core group (core + complementary + open course) / 45% marks in the part III.

#### M.A English 20 seats

Graduation in English under (Model-I/II/III) or graduation in other faculties of language and literature, social science, science, oriental studies are eligible for applying for MA programme in English provided they satisfy the eligibility criteria as given below.

Candidates should posses CGPA of 1.80 out of 4.00 / CCPa of 4.5 out of 10.00 in the Core Group (core plus open and complementary courses) / 45% marks in main & subsidiary subjects under Part III. However, if the CGPA scored by the graduate for common course is greater than the CGPA scored for core course, the CGPA scored cor common course will be taken into account for the calculation of index marks, provided they secure a minimum CGPA of 2.00 / CCPA of 5.00 for common course / 50% marks for Part I English.

#### **Msc. Mathematics**

12 seats

Graduation in Mathematics / Statistics / Computer Application with not less than, CGPA of 2.00 out of 4.00 / CCPA of 5.00 out of 10.00 in the Core Group (Core + Complementary + Open Courses) / 50% marks in the Part III.

#### **ADMISSION**

- 1. Centralized Allotment Process (CAP):50% of total seats including seats reserved for SC/ST/SEBC
- 2. Educational Agency Concerned: 50% of the total seats under management quota/sports and cultural quota/seats reserved for person with disabilities (PD)

Admission under Management quota: Candidate shall submit an application in the prescribed form with self-attested copies of SSLC and mark lists of the qualifying examination at the College Office, within the time specified by the University.

**Interview:** Candidates who are selected for admission will have to appear for an interview with fee and the originals of the following documents:

- a) Transfer Certificate (TC)
- b) Course and Conduct certificate
- c) SSLC with two copies
- d) Original mark lists of the qualifying examination with 3 copies
- e) Eligibility certificate from MG University, if the qualifying examination is passed from outside Kerala.
- f) Migration certificate for students who passed degree from outside MG University.
- g) Passport size photographs 3 nos.

#### **ATTENDANCE MONITORING**

3. A minimum of 75% of attendance in each subject and Lab is required for permitting the student to register for the university examination.

#### **FEE STRUCTURE**

Fee has to be paid at the College Office. Fee related to the first semester has to be remitted at the time of admission and fee related to all other semesters is to be remitted within the first five working days of each semester.

#### **GENERAL DISCIPLINE**

- 1. Students should reach the College before the first bell and be present in class room for the morning prayer.
- 2. Students will be permitted to enter the College campus only in uniform and with identity card.
- 3. Attendance will be taken within the first five minutes of every class/lab hours. Late comers on genuine grounds will be permitted to attend the class/lab, but attendance will be granted by the Principal only based on the written request from the student and forwarded by the teacher concerned and HoD.
